Ave Marie Grotto, Cullman, AL - This landscaped, 4-acre park provides a garden setting for 125 miniature reproductions of religious structures from around the world.

Edison & Ford Winter Estates Tour, Fort Myers, FL - 20 acres of historic buildings & gardens, the botanic research lab & the museum. Explore these beautiful estates along the scenic Caloosahatchee River.

Fort Myers River District - Enjoy some free time to explore the restaurants, local entertainment, or just do some shopping. Located along the Caloosahatchee River.

J. N. "Ding" Darling Wildlife Refuge, Sanibel Island, FL - Located on beautiful Sanibel Island, take a tram ride through one of the largest undeveloped mangrove ecosystems in the US. This refuge is habitat to more than 245 species of birds, mammals, reptiles, fish & invertebrates & home to the American alligator.

the largest populations of manatees in Florida. In the winter, these slow-moving "sea cows" congregate in the warm waters produced by the Florida Power & Light facilities.

Everglades City Airboat Tour - Get an up close look at alligators, otters, panthers, and more as we glide through the mangrove & grasslands.
